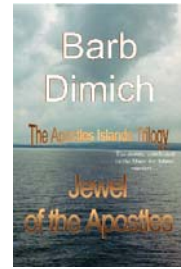
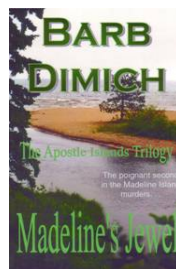
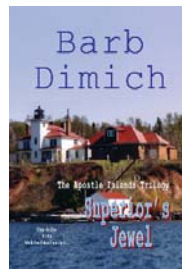

The New Book

Liberty's Justice, a new crime fiction story, was entered in the *Amazon Breakthrough Novel Award Contest*. The contest ran October 1, 2007 through November 5, 2007 and closed to the first 5000 entries. This Contest is intended to identify the "next great novel." One winner will receive a publishing contract with Penguin Group USA. All entries will be judged based on originality of idea, plot, prose/style, and overall strength of submission.

Here's the schedule leading up to the grand prize.

January 15, 2008	Up to 1,000 Semi-Finalists announced; Amazon customers can download, rate, and review excerpts on Amazon.com, providing feedback to Penguin Editors about submissions, and read Publisher's Weekly reviews of the full manuscripts
February 19, 2008	Top 100 Semi-Finalists announced. Penguin Editors reading Top 100 manuscripts to pick the 10 finalists Amazon customers continue to download, rate and review excerpts
March 3, 2008	10 Finalists announced Amazon customers vote to pick the winner
April 7, 2008	Amazon Breakthrough Novel Award winner announced

Liberty's Justice is set in Minnesota and pairs Duluth's Violent Crimes Unit with the FBI to hunt down a cyber crime predator. At first protesting, homicide detective Eve Boden and computer crime specialist Nate Quinn make an uneasy team. Against their better judgments, Boden must infiltrate the illicit world of sex in an undercover role while Quinn zealously strives to track an e-mail back to its source. As the killing continues, their gradual penetration into the high-tech crime world points in many directions, but when a Thai ship enters port with illegal cargo, Boden and Quinn find themselves up against an enormous web of corruption where powerful people who think they can do no wrong commit the worst kind of crime. Desperate, they must surreptitiously disobey their superiors to expose much more than murder. And no matter what it will cost them, they unite to stop the evil and catch a killer unlike any they have pursued before.
